## ALIV[H]E: Action Linking Interventions on Violence against women and HIV Everywhere

As a final part of the UNAIDS-commissioned programme on Applied research services on inter-linkages between Gender Based Violence and HIV, the partnership of the [Health Economics and HIV and AIDS Research Division \(HEARD\)](#), [Salamander Trust](#), [AIDS Legal Network](#), the [ATHENA Network](#) and [Project Empower](#) announce 5 webinars about the programme learning.

**MONDAY 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016:** The first webinar takes place on October 31st at UK 12:00 or Geneva 13:00; South Africa 14:00; E Africa 15:00; India UTC +5:30. It will take 2 hours. The focus of this first webinar is **on the importance and power of language.**

All five webinars (each lasting two hours) will focus on how programming and services in countries (from language, gender based violence/safety and HIV, participatory approaches and indicators) meaningfully involve and engage women and girls with disabilities; women and girls who are sex workers; lesbian, bisexual transgender and intersex (LBTGI) women and women and girls who use drugs.
